POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

By signing the following page (Participant Contract), participants (and parents) acknowledge that they have read and agree to abide by these policies.

Do not mail this page.

1. To confirm their place at the Festival, accepted participants must send an initial deposit payment of \$750 by April 15, 2009. The remaining balance of \$2,700 (less scholarship, if any) is due by May 15.
2. If a participant must withdraw from the Festival after full or partial funds have been paid, the refund schedule is as follows:
 - Withdrawal by May 15 – refund of total paid, minus \$500
 - Withdrawal by June 15 – refund of total paid, minus \$750
 - Withdrawal after June 15 – refund of total paid, minus \$1,000
3. Participants must complete and sign both a Participant Contract and a Medical Emergency Form to accompany their initial tuition deposit to confirm their place at the Festival.
4. The Westmont College campus is an entirely smoke-free, alcohol-free, drug-free and weapon-free facility. Smoking, use or possession of alcohol, illicit drugs or weapons of any kind may result in a fine of \$100.00. Repeated infractions may result in dismissal from the Festival.
5. Threats, acts of violence or intimidation, disregard for safety, intentional harm to self or others, vandalism, theft, destruction or defacement of property and graffiti of any kind will not be permitted, will be addressed as criminal activity by the appropriate authorities and will result in immediate dismissal from the Festival.
6. Participants under the age of 18 will be required to be in their dormitory rooms between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. Room checks will be conducted by dormitory monitors.
7. All participants must maintain quiet hours in the dormitories between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
8. Each participant will be issued a key to his or her dormitory room. There is a **\$40.00 FEE** for each lost key.
9. Participants under the age of 18 will not be allowed in dorm rooms of members of the opposite sex unless an approved chaperone is present.
10. Participants under the age of 18 will inform their assigned chaperones of their schedules. Their whereabouts will be verified during practice times and they will be required to attend all scheduled Festival sessions that apply to them (lectures, master classes, concerts, etc.).
11. Participants under the age of 18 will not be permitted to leave the campus without an approved chaperone.
12. No food is allowed in practice rooms.
13. Practice rooms are to be used for practicing. Sleeping, studying, reading, socializing, or other non-practicing activities in practice rooms may result in a loss of practice room privileges.
14. No participant will touch or move another participant's instrument without the express permission of the owner.
15. Dormitory rooms are to remain locked at all times and practice rooms are to remain unlocked at all times. Personal items must not be left unattended in practice rooms at any time.
16. All participants are expected to exercise discretion and consideration for others in practicing. Designated practice rooms and times will be assigned to all participants and there will be access to practice rooms at other times. There will be no practicing in dorm rooms from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Practicing in dorm rooms from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. may only take place with the consent of roommates and neighbors.
17. Failure to abide by any of the Festival Policies and Guidelines may result in dismissal from the Festival. Any transportation or accommodation costs incurred as a result of a participant's early dismissal will be the participant's (or their family's) responsibility.
